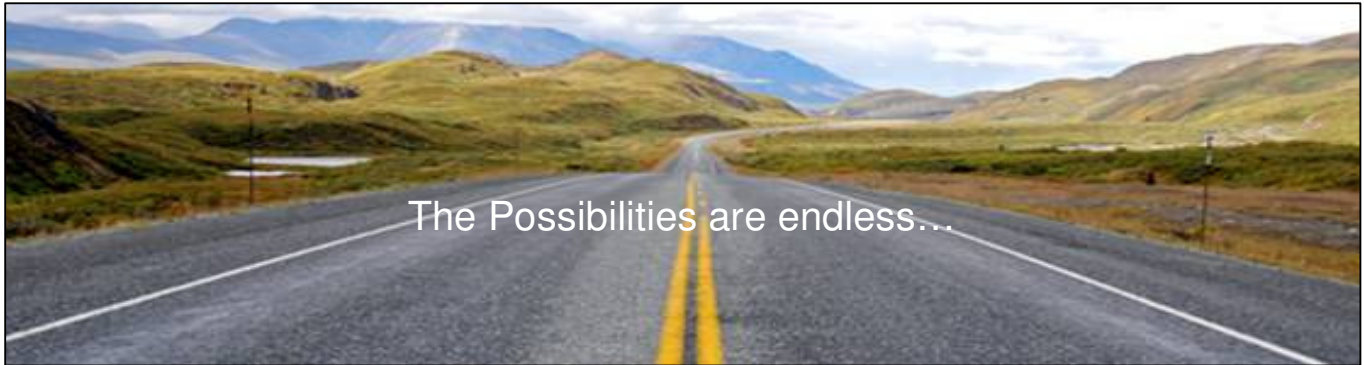

Program Changes

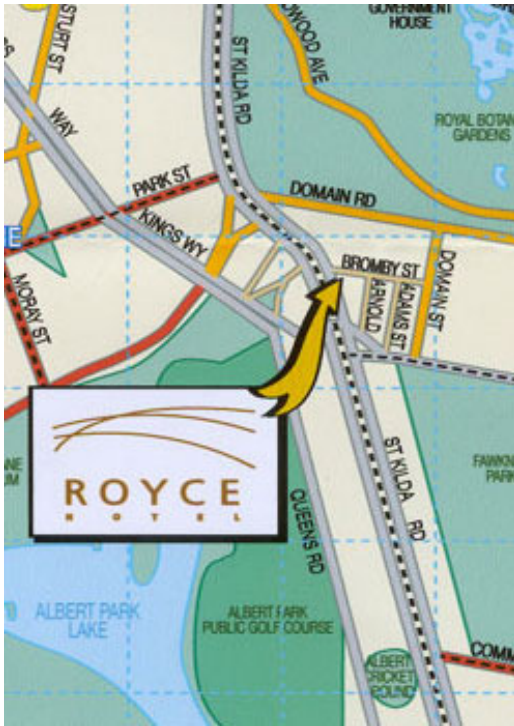
